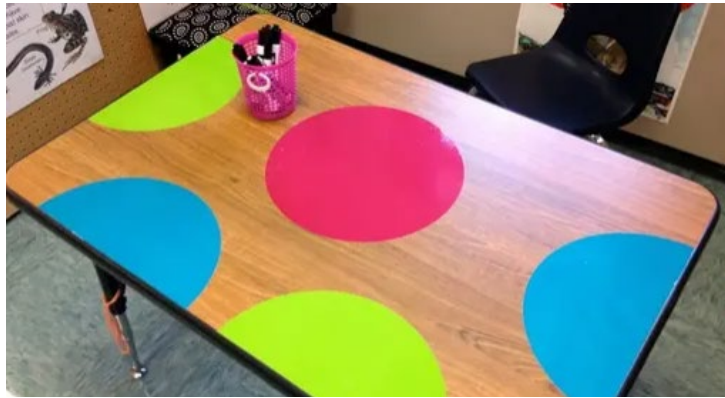
Classroom on a Budget
